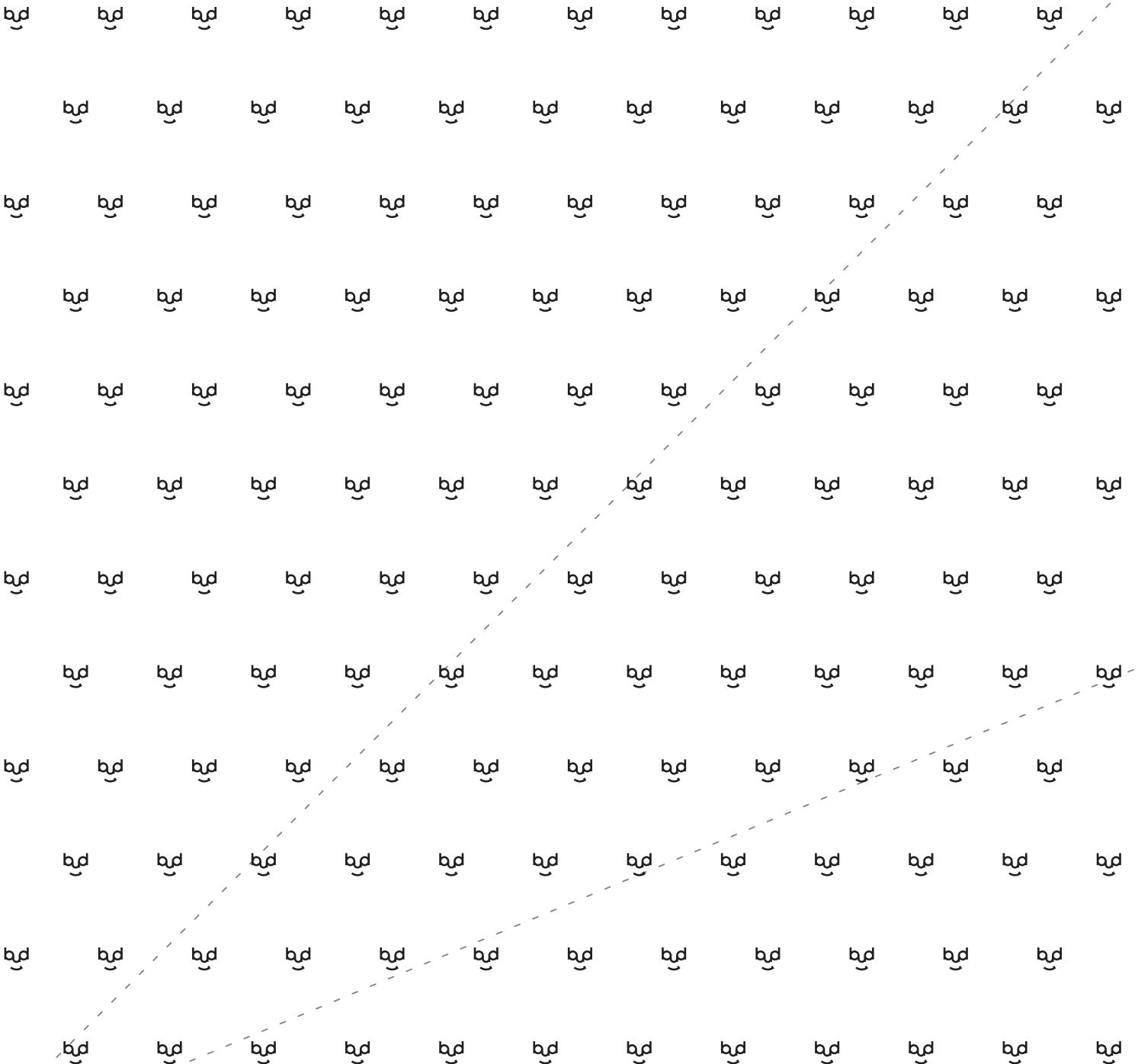


# bud bud brand
